





BE KIND TO ANIMALS - KID'S DAY AT PMHS!

The annual Kid's Day event at Pope Memorial Humane Society has become a tradition for animal-loving families. A signature humane education event, Kid's Day at Pope Memorial Humane Society, is filled with activities centered around giving back to homeless pets in need, helping them get adopted, and raising awareness of being kind to all animals.

- Be Kind to Animals Kid's Day began at PMHS in 2017, the first full year the shelter was in the new building.
- Kid's Day spans three hours and will see 300+ children and their families visit the shelter for fun and education.
- Always held the Saturday before Mother's Day, the kids are all invited to make a special craft for mom.

- The primary audience for PMHS is women ages 35-65 years old. We see that trend continue on Kid's Day with parents/grandparents/guardians bringing their children for an afternoon of fun.

















FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS CRAFT SHOW

The Festival of Lights Craft Show is an annual Midcoast tradition. Always held the Saturday after Thanksgiving, this event is part of a massive holiday celebration throughout the Midcoast community.

- More than 1,000 people attended the 43rd Annual Festival of Lights Craft Show in 2023.
- The Festival of Lights Craft Show has a minimum of 40 local crafters and artisans every year.
- There is a waiting list of crafters and artisans who want to have tables at the show.
- In addition to crafter table fees, Pope Memorial Humane Society raises money through entry fees, silent auction, and bake sale.

DEMOGRAPHICS

- The primary audience for PMHS is women ages 35-65 years old.
 We see that trend continue at the annual Festival of Lights Craft Show, with over 1,000 attendees.
- While many locals attend the event, we see a high number of attendees travel from the Capital Region, Downeast, and Greater Portland areas.















POPE MEMORIAL HUMANE SOCIETY PET ANGEL TREE

The Pope Memorial Humane Society Pet Angel Tree was launched in 2018. What began as a fun and festive way for the community to give back to homeless pets in need during the holiday season has turned into the largest donation drive of the year, ensuring the animals of PMHS have enough supplies to get through the chilly Maine winter months!

- In 2023 Ruckus Donuts, Laurel's Dolce Vita, and Affinity Nutrition hosted satellite trees for their customers to support homeless pets at PMHS.
- Over 1,000 tags are made each year.
- The PMHS community room is practically filled by the end of December with gifts for the animals.

DEMOGRAPHICS

 This is an all-ages project and event. Families, couples, friends, co-workers, students, and local business owners all support the PMHS Pet Angel Tree.

Legacy Luncheon

The PMHS Legacy Luncheon is hosted locally every year to honor our Legacy Society Members. Legacy Society Members have included PMHS in their planned giving. Their gift has a profound and lasting impact on the quality of life for shelter animals

Moms and Toms Program

Through this program, PMHS offers free spay surgery for cats and dogs that have recently given birth. The mother and babies are fixed, and the mother is returned to the owner. The puppies/kittens are vaccinated, treated for worms and fleas, spayed/neutered when old enough, microchipped, and adopted into loving homes. If Dad resides in the same house, we'll fix him too. Working together, we help prevent future unplanned litters. Each situation is unique, and we work closely with families to help stop cycles of unwanted litters being born in our community.

Spay/Neuter Voucher Assistance

At PMHS, we promote spaying and neutering for pets to curb overpopulation, enhance pet health, and address behavioral issues. To assist low-income residents in our service area, we provide spay/neuter assistance vouchers, offering up to \$100 towards the procedure at participating local veterinary facilities.

Saint's Fund

Deciding when to let your pet go is a difficult decision. Pope Memorial Humane Society doesn't want financial hardship to be an issue when euthanasia is the most humane choice for a pet's quality of life. PMHS's Saint's Fund is available to pet owners residing in our service area who are facing financial hardship in affording the peaceful and humane euthanasia of their pet. PMHS provides pet owners a Saint's Fund voucher on a case-by-case basis with veterinarian approval to provide financial help for these procedures.

Pet Food Assistance

No one should struggle to feed their pet; for those who are, PMHS is here to help. Community members needing pet food support should call the shelter at 207-594-2200 to request food for their pets. Community members are asked to provide the number and type of pets needing food and the town where they reside. Then, we will set an appointment for food pickup. In addition to our food assistance program, PMHS also partners with Meals on Wheels of Knox County. When resources allow, PMHS regularly provides local pet food pantries with pet food, helping their community members.























Every year, Pope Memorial Humane Society (PMHS) opens its doors to countless animals in need, providing them with a safe haven and a second chance. In 2023, that commitment was tested like never before, as we experienced a nearly 20% increase in animal intake, welcoming 1,350+ animals through our doors.

Despite this surge, PMHS remained unwavering in our mission. The PMHS open-admission policy ensures that no animal is turned away, regardless of health, age, or breed. Each receives the medical care they need, a warm bed, nutritious meals, and, most importantly, a chance to heal and find love.

This surge in need is a testament to the trust our community places in PMHS. But it also has stretched PMHS resources to the limit. PMHS relies on the generosity of individuals and businesses like yours to ensure the continued care of every animal who walks through the shelter's doors.


